

## Facts from the Town Board Meeting June, 2011

**Eagle Scout** Oisin O'Reilly was recognized for attaining the rank of Eagle Scout. Congratulations Oisin!!!

**Supervisor's Report** Concern was expressed for Roxanne Myers following her accident, and the supervisor praised our rescue squad for their quick response. It was noted that Stanford has NY State's oldest cooperative nursery school. The Supervisor thanked the American Legion for their Memorial Day tribute. Big Rock's farm stand opens this month.

**Noise Complaints** Several complaints about noise have been received from throughout the Town. Councilmen Dewhirst and D'Agostino volunteered to mediate a noise dispute between two neighbors and a committee including the neighbors was formed. Counsel advised that Town Boards do not get involved in neighbor disputes. The Board's function is to look at whether or not the Town is interested in a noise ordinance. The committee was disbanded and Councilman D'Agostino wanted to mediate as a private citizen. The Board is reviewing noise ordinances in other towns.

**Website Policy** Supervisor Stern proposed two additions to the web policy as suggested by Attorney Bogle: that the Board be responsible for content, types and categories of information that would be put on the website and to have any new categories approved first by the Board; that design and format also are the Board's responsibility and that changes need to be approved by the Board.
